RULES This series is open to all 2002 members or associate (charterers) members of the J/105 Class and will be governed by the 2001-2004 *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), the J/105 Class Rules for 2002 (except as amended below), this Notice and Conditions of Race and the Sailing Instructions, except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions.

This shall be a category B event except that crew members other than the helmsman may be Category 1, 2 or 3 who shall not be paid to race. Category 1 charterers who are not J/105 owners may enter provided that the driver is Category 1.

SERIES SCORING As many 16 races may be sailed. All

races shall be weighted equally on a low point basis with first place counting 1 pt. The lowest score shall be discarded, allowing a boat to skip the Quicksilver Cup between weekends.

FREE BOAT STORAGE For boats competing in this event and then continuing to Key West Race Week and the SORC, Charleston Boatworks has offered to park boats on trailers at their yard gratis. This offer extends into 2003 for boats attending Charleston Race Week in April 2003.

PRIZES In addition to a new Fall Championship Perpetual Trophy, prizes will be awarded to race winners and for the 1st through 5th place yachts overall in the series.

Individual event trophies will also be awarded by host organizations for the SAYRA Offshores, Columbus Day Cup, Quicksilver Cup and Calibogue Cup.
