By signing below, you are declaring that you are an Owner of the boat and that the driver of your boat during the regatta(s) specified above will be in conformity with Part 3 of the J105 Class Rules (Membership and Eligibility), Level A. Specifically:

- the driver is an Active or Associate Member of the J105 Class Association and this year's dues have been paid;
- the driver is a Group 1 competitor under the ISAF classification system;
- if the driver's is in any way related to the sailing industry, the driver has obtained an ISAF classification as a Group I competitor, which classification you have confirmed is shown on ISAF's website; and
- the driver is either (a) a member of my immediate family or the immediate family of another Owner of my boat or (b) a long term shipmate and friend of mine or another Owner of the boat. I understand that in order for an individual to be a long term shipmate and friend of an Owner, that individual must (i) during the immediately preceding 12 months, have sailed with that Owner on at least 6 race days and (ii) during the immediately preceding 24 months, have sailed with that Owner in at least 50% of all races in which the Owner competed, including races in boats other than a J105.

Roughly, Group 1 is an amateur competitor, Group 2 is a marine industry competitor, and Group 3 is a professional competitor. Under our class rules, if a person is sailing industry related, he is deemed a Group 3 unless he or she has obtained a classification from ISAF, which can be done on-line in a few minutes (at least if you're not working in the sailing industry).
