#### 1. New Signature Requirement

Because there are fewer and fewer US Sailing Certified measurers, our registration forms must now be signed by the sail loft owner.

#### 2. Weight of spinnaker cloth

If Submission #5 passes early in 2006, then all spinnakers delivered after 2/1/2006 shall be made of cloth whose published weight is 44 gsm or greater.

#### 3. Barberhauling Interpretation

A new barberhauling rule (5.3.8, 5.3.10) and interpretation (RI-05-05) goes into effect on 1/1/2006. The only barberhauling permitted is with the lazy sheet running directly from the clew around the front of the mast to a windward winch without any intermediate turns or leads.
